The billing period is from the previous bill issued to the current bill.

This is billing activity on the account, including any adjustments, previous balances, payments, penalties, past due amounts and current charges.

This is the total amount charged for water.


These are the dollar amounts and billing units for water indicated by each tier.

Sewer is the fixed cost of the District to provide water service.

Flat Charge is the fixed cost of the District to provide water service.

WR & ES CHG is the Water Reliability and Emergency Storage Charge that funds three capital projects.

The past due amount must be paid by this date to avoid receiving a 10% penalty and disconnection notice hung on the door.



Bills are due upon receipt and this is the last day to pay the bill.

The red asterisk is an alert to customers that if this amount includes a past due balance, that portion needs to be paid by the date on the bottom of the billing statement.

The amount due is all the \$\$\$ owing on the account, including any previous unpaid balance plus penalty incurred.

The meter reading dates indicate when your meter was actually read. The date may vary each month.

This is the usage for this account last year at this time.

This is the total usage for the current billing period. The meters are read in 100 cubic feet of water, so 75 billing units equates to 7500 cubic feet of water.
